PHASE II 6-8 weeks	Advance 25% weekly until full	None	Full	Advance Phase I exercises
PHASE III 8-12	Full	None	Full	Gait training, begin closed chain activities: wall sits, shuttle, minisquats, toe raises  Begin unilateral stance activities,
weeks				balance training
PHASE IV  12 weeks - 6	Full	None	Full	Advance Phase III exercises; maximize core/glutes, pelvic stability work, eccentric hamstrings
months				May advance to elliptical, bike, pool as tolerated
PHASE V				Advance functional activity
6-12 months	Full	None	Full	Return to sport-specific activity and impact when cleared by MD after 8 mos
